Exclusion 8 is amended to read:  8. for the delayed departure of the ship, aircraft or train on which an Insured Person is booked to travel, due to strike, labour dispute, mechanical breakdown or failure of a means of transport, where the delay lasts for less than 24 hours other than for the Travel Delay cover
Cancellation or Curtailment and Rearrangement covers now include sustenance.
Age limit increased to 80 years of age.
The wording has been clarified to state:  This agreement will not apply to:  d) any difference that is as a result of any cover, limit, terms or condition that is deemed to form part of a life licence as required by the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 (Regulated Activities) Order 2001 (or subsequent amends thereof) and section 73 of the Solvency II Directive.
